GEORGE

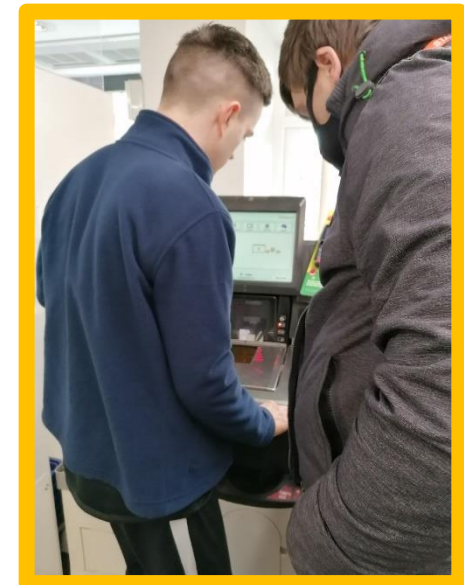
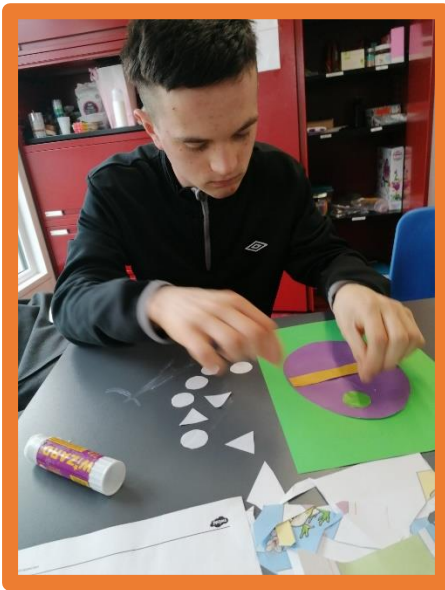


George has enjoyed...

HARRY

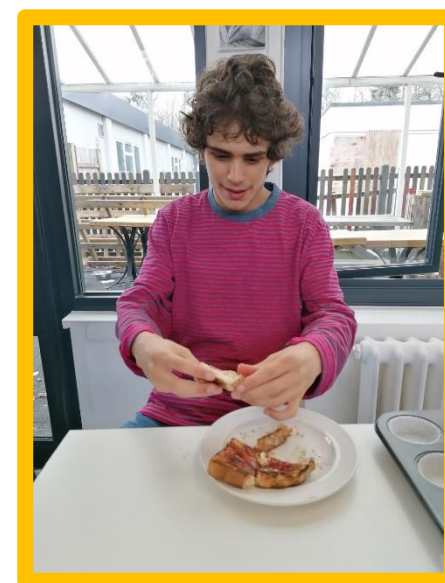
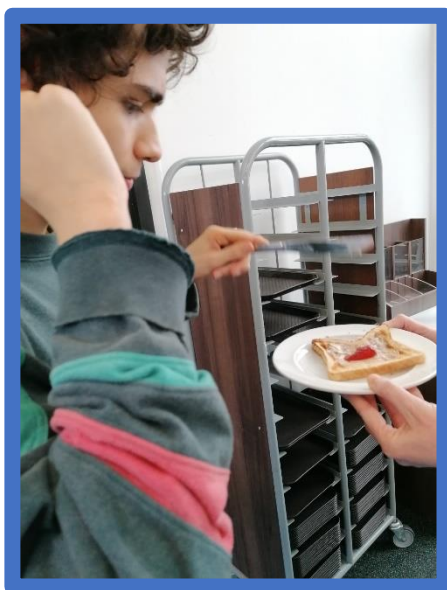


Harry has enjoyed...
