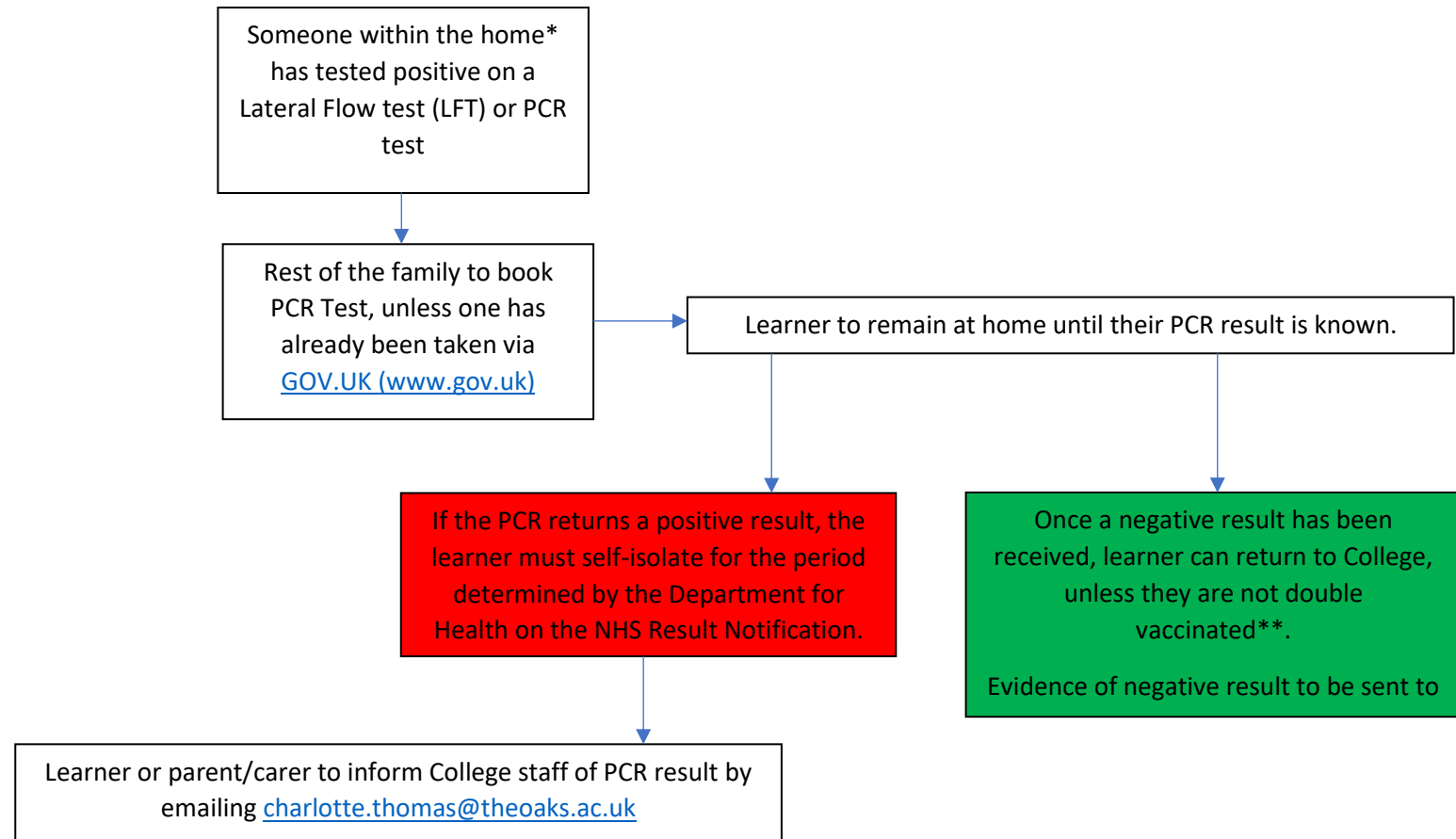


## Outbreak Management Plan

Scenario: Learner displays symptoms or tests positive on a lateral flow test at home.

The College Leadership Team request all families read and carry out the following process in the event of having a case of Covid 19 within a learner's household\*.



\*This includes supported living placements  
\*\* If a learner is not double vaccinated, then they MUST self-isolate for the full 10 days regardless of the PCR result.

## Booking your PCR test online

### Getting a PCR test if you have no symptoms

You can also use this service if:

- you've been in contact with someone who's tested positive
- you've been asked to get a test by a local council or someone from NHS Test and Trace
- a GP or other health professional has asked you to get a test
- you're taking part in a government pilot project
- you've been asked to get a test to confirm a positive result
- you've received an unclear result and were told to get a second test
- you need to get a test for someone you live with who has symptoms
- you're in the National Tactical Response Group

### Does the person who needs a test currently have any coronavirus symptoms?

- Yes, they currently have symptoms
- No, they do not currently have symptoms

**!** If they have a high temperature, a new continuous cough, or loss or change to their sense of smell or taste, they should stay at home until they get their result. They can leave home to get or post a test. [Check if people they live with need to self-isolate on NHS.UK.](#)

### Is the person who needs a test an essential worker?

Essential workers include NHS staff, teachers and transport staff. Check the [full list of essential workers on GOV.UK.](#)

### Is the person who needs a test part of a trial or government pilot project?

For example, they have been invited to take part in the Contact Testing Study:

- The person was told to get a test by the COVID Symptom Study app (by ZOE)
- The person has been invited to take part in the Contact Testing Study
- Attended an event as part of the Events Research Programme in the last 21 days

or

- None of the above

## Why are you asking for a test?

If you are getting a test for someone you live with, answer for them:

- I've been in contact with someone who's tested positive for coronavirus
- Contact tracers told me to get a test
- The contact tracing app told me to get a test (the NHS COVID-19, Protect Scotland or StopCOVID NI app)
- I found out in another way that I'm a contact (England, Wales and Scotland only)
- I was asked to get a test because I visited a venue where others have since tested positive



You will now be able to enter your own personal details to book the test.

You can add up to 3 further family members in addition to the person initially requiring the test.
